What is House Bill 39 (HB39)?

The Illinois Constitution states that a person in prison "shall lose the right to vote, which right shall be restored not later than upon completion of his sentence." The exact length of disenfranchisement is not specified.

HB39 restores the right to vote for voters in prison post-conviction.
